No. 20 Georgia 5, Georgia Tech 2

The No. 20 Georgia men's tennis team came back to defeat its rival Georgia Tech, 5-2, winning its 13th-straight match against the Yellow Jackets on Tuesday evening at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex.

Despite dropping the doubles point, the Bulldogs (4-1) won five singles matches, with Cyrus Mahjoob clinching the match on court six. The freshman closed out a three-set win over Georgia Tech's (7-2) Rohan Sachdev, 4-6, 6-2, 6-3, earning the second match-clinching win of his career. Georgia is now 37-1 in its previous 38 matches against its in-state rival.

"It took serious maturity from our young guys to win today," head coach Manuel Diaz said. "I couldn't ask for better matches from our veterans, Thomas and Miguel. It was just an outstanding win by Thomas at number one singles against one of the country's top players. He's come such a long way. Our team unity is making a big difference. We have a very young team with three freshmen in the bottom three positions and out there in doubles as well. They just showed a lot of toughness, losing the first set at four and six, and had a lot of resolve and willpower to do what needed to be done. It wasn't about playing great; it was about just making more balls and being a little bit tougher, not looking for shortcuts. Our young guys did a tremendous job."

Georgia dropped the doubles point for the first time this season, losing on courts one and two. Ryan Colby and Thomas Paulsell went down two breaks early on court two and could not battle back, falling by a 6-2 score. On court one, Freddy Blaydes and Niels Ratiu went up a break to begin their match but could not capitalize on the advantage and lost their first match together, 6-3.

Moving into singles competition, the Bulldogs eventually fell behind in the match after No. 36 Colby lost for the first time this season on court three. Despite trailing 2-0, Georgia would go on to win all five remaining matches. Blaydes defeated Elias Shokry, 6-3, 6-3, earning his first singles victory on court five. No. 43 Miguel Perez Peña found himself down a break in the first set but battled back to take it, eventually winning his first career match on court two over Keshav Chopra in straight sets. On court one, No. 41 Thomas Paulsell beat Andres Martin, 7-5, 6-4, and put the contest at match point in Georgia's favor. Both Martin and Chopra were 7-8 in singles headed into today's match.

All eyes came down to court six, where No. 112 Mahjoob was in a third set, looking to break Sachdev one final time to clinch the match. The Rockville, Md. native went on to win his 15th match of the year, tied for most on the team. Ratiu then capped off the day by picking up the first ranked win of his collegiate career with a 5-7, 6-4, 6-3 decision against No. 67 Gabriele Brancatelli.

I don't even know if I explain my emotions after clinching match," Mahjoob said. "After I realized I won the last point, and I looked over to see my guys, who want me to win, that love me, all sprinting towards the court to celebrate together. There were so many emotions going through my head. In the third set, I was just worried about myself staying poised, but the support from Georgia was unreal. It's empowering me while also making the other guy feel how tough it is to win out here. Knowing that there's our whole team, the coaches, everyone on the sides that loves you and want you to win as badly as you do is insane."

Georgia's next two matches will come on the road. The Bulldogs will head to Charlottesville, Va. to take on No. 3 Virginia, the two-time defending National Champions, on Friday, Feb. 9 at 5 p.m. ET. The team will then travel to Chapel Hill, N.C. and play No. 17 North Carolina on Sunday, Feb. 11 at 1 p.m. to close out the week.

THE FIRST SERVE - NOTES VS. VIRGINIA + NORTH CAROLINA

Virginia

 No. 20 Georgia's second match of the weekend against No. 3 Virginia, the two-time reigning NCAA National Champion, is a contest between two blue-blood programs. The Bulldogs and Cavaliers combine for 12 team national titles, which is over 15 percent of all National Championships recognized since 1946.

North Carolina

- Georgia will be searching for its first win at Chapel Hill in program history. Of the 23 matches played in the series, 17 of them were played in the Classic City, four at neutral sites in postseason matchups and just two played in North Carolina.
- •The Tar Heels have hosted the Bulldogs twice on Feb. 2, 2003, and in the second round of the NCAA Tournament on May 4, 2019. North Carolina won both matches by a 5-2 and 4-1 score, respectively.

MANUEL DIAZ - HEAD COACH

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- \cdot 771-193 career record (.799) in his 36 seasons at the helm of the program
- · Won his 709th career match as head coach during the shortened 2020 dual-match season, passing his mentor Dan Magill to become the winningest coach in SEC history

<u>New-Look Bulldogs</u>

Georgia's 2023-24 roster includes six new freshmen and a transfer. The team has enrolled five-stars Cyrus Mahjoob and Davis Taylor, four stars Parker Jacques and Parker Mariencheck as well as Belgium-native Niels Raitu. The Bulldogs also signed USC transfer Ryan Colby, a former blue-chip prospect and All-Pac 12 honoree. Freddy Blaydes, who has a career-high International Tennis Federation world juniors ranking of No. 117 and signed with the program in September, joined the team at the beginning of January.

Juniors Thomas Paulsell, Miguel Perez Peña and redshirt sophomore Filipe Costa are the only three players from the 2023 SEC regular season championship team still on the roster. Five of the remaining six used their final year of eligibility last season while Ethan Quinn opted to begin his professional career after winning the NCAA singles national championship in May.

Fantastic Fall

The Bulldogs had an impressive start to the year, claiming tournament titles in all three of their five fall events that multiple players participated in.

Perez Peña won the ITA Southeast Regional Singles Championship on Oct. 16 at the Ken Byers Tennis Complex, defeating South Florida's [12] Alvin Tudorica 7-6(5), 6-1. He joins Blake Croyder as the second consecutive Bulldog to win the title. His win marked the sixth time since 2013 that a Georgia player has won the singles regional championship. The Castellon de la Plana, Spain native clinched his spot at the ITA National Fall Championships after defeating teammate Cyrus Mahjoob in the semifinals.

Georgia claimed the singles and doubles titles in the red draw at the Southern Intercollegiate Championships on Oct. 1. In an all-Bulldog singles final, Thomas Paulsell earned a 6-4, 6-4, win over Perez Peña to win the red draw singles championship. In doubles, Ryan Colby and Niels Ratiu defeated Clemson's Noa Vukadin and Maxwell Smith, 8-6, in the finals. Colby and Ratiu are now 6-2 in doubles this fall.

Before the Southern Intercollegiate Championships, Colby's Bulldog career got off to a strong start at the Longhorn Invitational, winning the event's championship. A junior, Colby went 3-0 in singles with a pair of wins over top-25 players. He managed to beat No. 112 Loris Pourroy (FSU), No. 17 Micah Braswell (Texas), marking the highest-ranked win of his career, and former teammate No. 22 Peter Makk (USC) to end the weekend undefeated.

Georgia's successes earned the team a No. 18 national ranking, also putting four athletes in the ITA singles rankings and a pair in the doubles poll to begin the dual-match season. Colby leads the team with a No. 36 ranking, closely followed by No. 41 Thomas Paulsell, who picked up his highest-ranked win against 46th-ranked Nemanja Malesevic (Miss. St.) at the Georgia Tech Invitational. No. 43 Perez Peña and freshman No. 112 Cyrus Mahjoob close out the ranked Bulldogs in singles. In doubles, No. 42 Colby and Ratiu earned a spot after a 7-3 start together.

Diaz Enters 36th Season

Manuel Diaz – the SEC's all-time wins leader with 767 career victories — begins his 36th season as the Georgia men's tennis coach. Diaz led the Bulldogs to another conference championship and a deep run in the NCAA tournament in 2023.

The United States Tennis Association Southern Tennis Hall of Fame coach has guided Georgia to 29 SEC championships, four NCAA national titles (1999, 2001, 2007 and 2008) and two Intercollegiate Tennis Association indoor national championships in 36 years. He has been named SEC Coach of the Year on seven occasions and the ITA National Coach of the Year three times.

Most recently, the Bulldogs captured the SEC crown with a perfect 12-0 conference record on their way to the NCAA quarterfinals. Under Diaz's guidance, redshirt freshman Quinn became just the fourth rookie since 1977 to win the NCAA singles championship and the third Georgia player to accomplish the feat, joining the elite company of Mikael Pernfors and Matias Boeker.

Scouting the Cavaliers

Virginia entered this week's ITA team rankings at No. 6 after back-toback losses at No. 1 Ohio State and at No. 16 Kentucky. The Cavaliers were without their top-ranked player, No. 19 Chris Rodesch, who Ethan Quinn defeated in the NCAA Singles Tournament semifinals in 2023, in the previous two matches.

Inaki Montes de la Torre checked in at No. 45 in the most recent singles rankings with a 5-3 record but has yet to play in a dual match this season. No. 56 Jeffrey von der Schulenberg played on court one in Virginia's previous two matches but has typically played in the third position. No. 104 Mans Dahlberg anchors the singles lineup, holding a 3-1 record on court six.

The Cavaliers lone representative in the doubles rankings are No. 12 Montes de la Torre and James Hopper. The pair advanced to the semifinals at the ITA All-American Championships together in October.

Scouting the Tar Heels

North Carolina now stands at No. 25 in the team rankings after losing at Illinois, 4-2, on Saturday, Feb. 3. The Tar Heels hold a 3-3 record, falling to the Fighting Illini twice and the Florida Gators.

In singles, No. 60 Benjamin Kittay is the team's top-ranked player. He has a 2-2 record on court three in the spring after going 4-1 in the fall. No. 75 Karl Poling, North Carolina's choice for court two, is 7-7 on the year. William Jansen plays on court one, where he has a 3-2 record, is ranked No. 94. No. 110 Will Peters currently has 17 singles wins, good for most on the team.


